

TOWN OF AURORA, NC
BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS' MINUTES
March 23, 2020 Meeting Recessed From March 2, 2020

A regular/recessed meeting of the Aurora Town Board of Commissioners was held at 7:00 P.M. on Monday, March 23, 2020, at the Town Hall. Mayor Clif Williams called the meeting to order with the following present:

A motion to approve the proposed agenda was made by Commissioner Lee, seconded by Commissioner Jordan with a 4 to 0 vote.

Mayor Williams opened the Public Hearing to receive Public Comment on the Proposed Amendments to the Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance and updated 2020 Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIRMS) Approved by FEMA. After some discussion a motion was made by Commissioner Peed to close the public hearing, which was seconded by Commissioner Lee with a 4 to 0 vote.

A motion was then made by Commissioner Lee to adopt the proposed 2020 amendments to the Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance and updated Flood Insurance Rate Maps. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Jordan with a 4 to 0 vote.

Mayor Williams asked for a motion to open the Public Hearing to receive Public Comment on the proposed Land Purchase Funding Agreement with Beaufort County for the Aurora Industrial Park. Commissioner Jordan made this motion, which was seconded by Commissioner Lee with a 4 to 0 vote.

Mayor Williams gave a brief progress report which included that the County Commissioners had unanimously approved the funding agreement on March 9th and that the Golden Leaf Foundation had agreed to the requested advancement of \$40,000.00 to complete the engineering services performed by The East Group. Following a short discussion on proposed leasing companies; the Mayor asked for a motion to close the public hearing. The motion was made by Commissioner Peed and seconded by Commissioner Lee with a 4 to 0 vote.

The Mayor then asked for a motion to approve the proposed Land Purchase Funding Agreement with Beaufort County for the Aurora Industrial Park. The motion was made by Commissioner Peed and seconded by Commissioner Jordan with a 4 to 0 vote.

The March 23, 2020 recessed meeting adjourned on a motion made by Commissioner Lee, second by Commissioner Jordan with a 4 to 0 vote.
