

**TOWN OF AURORA, NC**  
**BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS' MINUTES**  
**Recessed June 20, 2022 Meeting**  
**(From June 6, 2022)**

A recessed meeting of the Aurora Town Board of Commissioners was held at 7:00 P.M. on Monday, June 20, 2022, at the Town Hall. Mayor Williams Mayor Williams reopened the meeting to order with the following present:

A motion to approve the proposed Recessed Agenda was made by Commissioner Bahhur and seconded by Commissioner Taylor with a 3 to 0 vote.

Mayor Williams opened the Public Hearing to receive Public Comment on the proposed 2022-2023 fiscal year budget. With no comment from the public, a motion was made by Commissioner Jordan to close the public hearing. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Bahhur and passed with a 3 to 0 vote.

The Clerk presented the proposed 2022-2023 fiscal year budget. Increases in expenditure for water and sewer had been assessed and a 10% increase had been approved in May for both utilities. Further increases in smaller increments are expected. The General Fund has been impacted by the economy and the cost of fuel which is driving up the cost of goods and services. A motion to approve the proposed 2022-2023 fiscal year budget was made by Commissioner Jordan and seconded by Commissioner Bahhur, with a 3 to 0 vote

The Clerk notified the Board that the Town was still eligible for the 2021 Community Waste Reduction and Recycling Grant Program through NC DEQ. We had applied for funding for a chipper but as of this date we have been able to locate one. NC DEQ will guide us through the contract amendment process to extend the time period if council wishes to do so. A motion to move forward with the CWRAR grant by amending the time period in order to locate a suitable chipper was made by Commissioner Jordan and seconded by Commissioner Bahhur and passed with a 3 to 0 vote.

There being no further business, a motion was made by Commissioner Jordan, seconded by Commissioner Buhhur and approved with a 3 to 0 vote to adjourn the meeting.
