Continuing under Old Business the Clerk presented the Resolution to Appoint Citizen Committees to form the Aurora Leadership Council. A motion to approve the resolution was made by Commissioner Peed and seconded by Commissioner Jordan with a 3 to vote.

Under New Business, the Clerk provided a resolution to approve the annual lease agreement with BHM Regional Library for the Hazel W. Guilford Library. A motion was made by Commissioner Lee, seconded by Commissioner Peed and approved with a 3 to 0 vote to approve the Resolution and annual Lease with BHM Library.

Public Works Director Chuck Bonner gave a report on the Water Treatment Plant Upgrade and we hope to have a final walk through this month or in October. Regarding the Emergency Generators, he is working with a company called CB Energy Solutions who, along with Hicks Propone will insure that the generators are correctly installed. Work is continuing on ditch maintenance and storm water drains.

Recreation Coordinator Curt Hendrix o provided an oral report which highlighted continued maintenance of the athletic fields and the girls' softball league. The town walking group is proving to be very popular and continues to grow each week. He is looking in to starting "Pickle Ball" under the recreation program and he will have more to report on that ongoing.

There being no further business, a motion was made by Commissioner Lee and seconded by Commissioner Peed and approved with a 3 to 0 vote to adjourn the meeting.
